



VOTING IN THE MAY 6 SINKING FUND RENEWAL ELECTION

The State of Michigan Secretary of State Office requires residents to register to vote by April 7 to vote in the May 6th Sinking Fund Renewal election.

ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible to vote if you meet all of these requirements:

- You are at least 18 years old by May 6, 2014
- You are a U.S. citizen
- You are a resident of Michigan
- You are a resident of the city/township where you apply to vote

REGISTERING

To check whether you are registered, go to <https://webapps.sos.state.mi.us/mivote>

Need to register? Applications are available at these locations:

- A Secretary of State branch office (4256 W. Vienna Road, Clio; or find other branches at <http://services.sos.state.mi.us/servicelocator/branchofficelocator.aspx>)
- Your local county, city, or township clerk's office

Fill out the application, then:

- Turn in the application in person to your city or township clerk's office, or
- Mail in the application, including required identification (locations at MMSinkingFundRenewal.weebly.com)
- First-time voters who do not turn in their applications in person must vote in person
- Look for your voter registration card in the mail
- Note: Since the address listed on your driver's license/state ID must match your voting registration, if you use a different address the Secretary of State will change your license/ID address and mail you a sticker to update your license/ID

VOTING

What to know:

On Election Day:

- Polls (voting locations) are open 7 a.m. - 8 p.m.

What's on the voting ballot?

Below is the exact language you will see when you vote on the Sinking Fund Renewal on May 6, 2014.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate of 2.5 mills (\$2.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in Mt. Morris Consolidated Schools, Genesee County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of ten (10) years, 2015 to 2024, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2015 is approximately \$491,799 (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2014 tax levy)?
